What is (CPA) Certified Public Accountant?

The Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Certificate is the most prestigious qualification for professionals who are engaged in public practice and senior financial positions. CPA holder can work and practice his/ her professionalism in different fields like accounting, auditing, Tax, and senior management.

How can I be certified as a CPA?

To be certified as a CPA, candidates must fulfill certain requirements as follows:

- ◆ Holder of at least a bachelor's degree in accounting or business related subjects from an accredited college or University;
- ◆ Currently most US States require at least 150 credit hours to fulfill educational requirements and
- ◆ Pass the CPA examination

What are the components of the CPA examination?

Part1: Financial Accounting and Reporting (FAR)

90 multiple choice questions and 7 task based simulations (4 Hours)

Part 2: Auditing and Attestation (AUD)

90 multiple choice questions and 7 task based simulations (4 Hours)

Part 3: Business Environment and Concepts (BEC)

72 multiple choice questions and 3 written communication tasks (3 Hours)

Part 4: Regulation (REG)

72 multiple choice questions and 6 task based simulations (3 Hours)

Who is responsible for CPA examination?

The examination is offered jointly through three organizations: AICPA, NASBA and Prometric. The AICPA is responsible for developing and scoring the examination, NABA is responsible for National candidate Data base and Prometric is responsible for examination delivery at authorized test centers.

Where and when is the CPA exam?

All examinations are offered by Prometric, a worldwide network of testing centers. The exam is offered in Kuwait in: January & February, April & May, July and August and October & November.
